

Camp Good Dog Consent and Liability Release

The Humane Society of Greenwood's (hereby known as "HSOG") Camp Good Dog for Kids is a fun, educational way to encourage your child to act with compassion and understanding towards animals. In order to assure a positive experience for all, we set guidelines for the safety and well-being of the students and the animals. There will be hands-on animal contact. Your child is expected to follow instructions from the Camp Director and Shelter staff and maintain appropriate conduct with a variety of animals. If your child is unable to follow these guidelines, he/she will be asked to leave the program.

In signing this agreement, I understand and agree to the following:

- I agree to arrange transportation for my child to and from HSOG. Camp starts promptly at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 11:30 a.m. Please have your child picked up on time. Due to safety and liability issues, children are not permitted to stay on the premises without supervision.
- In the performance of day camp experiences, there exists a risk of damage to clothing and other personal property. Please have your child wear appropriate clothing. Jeans and t-shirts are preferred. Camp t-shirt will be provided. Shorts and tank tops are discouraged. Students are required to wear either sneakers or boots, no sandals or open-toed shoes are allowed. Students with sensitive skin should wear sunscreen as we will be outside everyday during the camp sessions.
- I give HSOG permission to use photographs or video footage of my child's activities while participating in HSOG's Camp Good Dog for Kids.
- My child agrees to treat all of the animals, people and property at the facility with respect.
- My child agrees to stay in areas designated during Camp and not to trespass into restricted areas that are for employees only.
- I authorize HSOG to seek emergency medical treatment for my child in case of an accident, injury or illness and not to hold HSOG responsible in such an event. I understand that under HSOG's Workers Compensation policy, visitors are not classified as "employees" and therefore not eligible for coverage for injuries sustained while on the premises.
- I waive all claims against the Humane Society of Greenwood, the City and County of Greenwood, the State
 of South Carolina, and/or members, directors, employees, and volunteers for all personal injury and
 property damages resulting from my child participating in the Humane Society of Greenwood's Camp
 Good Dog for Kids.
