Our volunteers are an important asset to our organization and they do a remarkable job helping us help the animals. Volunteers help in almost every capacity of our operation. We are sure to have an opportunity that suits your interests and abilities.

**If you would like to join our volunteer team, here is what you need to do:**

1 - Complete an application. Applications are available at the Greenwood County Animal Shelter or on our website at: [www.gwdhumanesociety.org](http://www.gwdhumanesociety.org)

2 - Be 16 years of age or older. Youth ages can volunteer, but must be accompanied by a parent for all volunteer sessions.

3 - Attend a Volunteer Orientation session. The date of the upcoming Volunteer Orientation is announced on our website.

4 - Make a commitment to volunteer on a frequent and regular basis for at least six months.



- Socialize the animals by walking the dogs and playing with the cats.
- Bathe and brush the dogs and cats.
- Get first-hand shelter experience cleaning kennels, washing dishes and litter pans, and doing laundry.
- Work at off-site events, such as adoption days and fund raisers.
- Spend a day with other animal lovers working on mass mailings and other marketing projects.
- Put your special talents, such as carpentry, painting, data entry, landscaping/gardening, photography, organizing, in service of the animals.
